This spring, the Sherwood School District is offering an After School Enrichment Program that is designed to provide enriched and creative learning experiences for students at all Sherwood schools. Elementary, middle school, and high school students will have an opportunity to participate in a variety of activities intended to broaden their interests, skills, and abilities.

If you see a class at another school that your child is interested in, you can register for that class. In other words, students are welcome to register for classes at any school location. Please note that transportation between schools is not provided.

Registrations must be completed and turned in to school offices with payment in full by February 17. Class registration is based on a first come first serve basis. Therefore, registrations will be marked with the date and time received in each school office. If class size permits, late registrations will be accepted until classes begin.

Registration confirmations will be sent by email no later than one week prior to class start date, so please include a current email address on your registration form. If you do not have an email address, indicate that on your registration form and we will leave a message on your home phone confirming student registration.

Please note that regular behavior expectations will remain in effect for students attending the After School Enrichment Program. While no grades will be given for enrichment classes, teachers will provide parents feedback on student progress for skill building classes.
